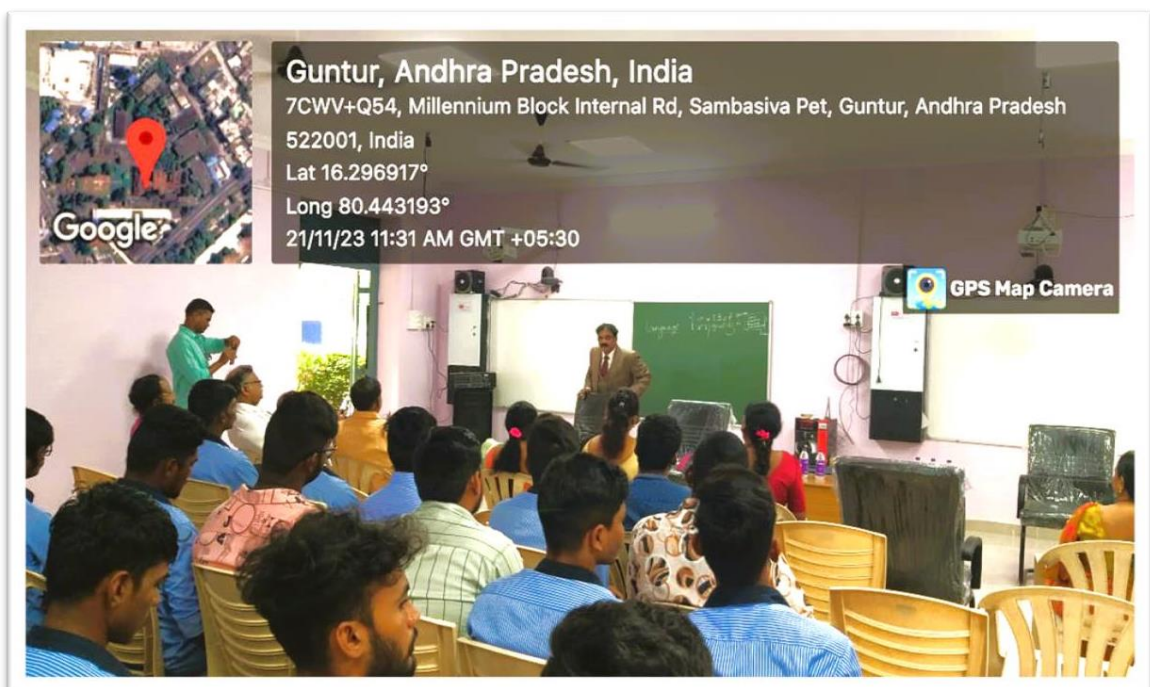
Guest Lecture on “Communication through Pronunciation”

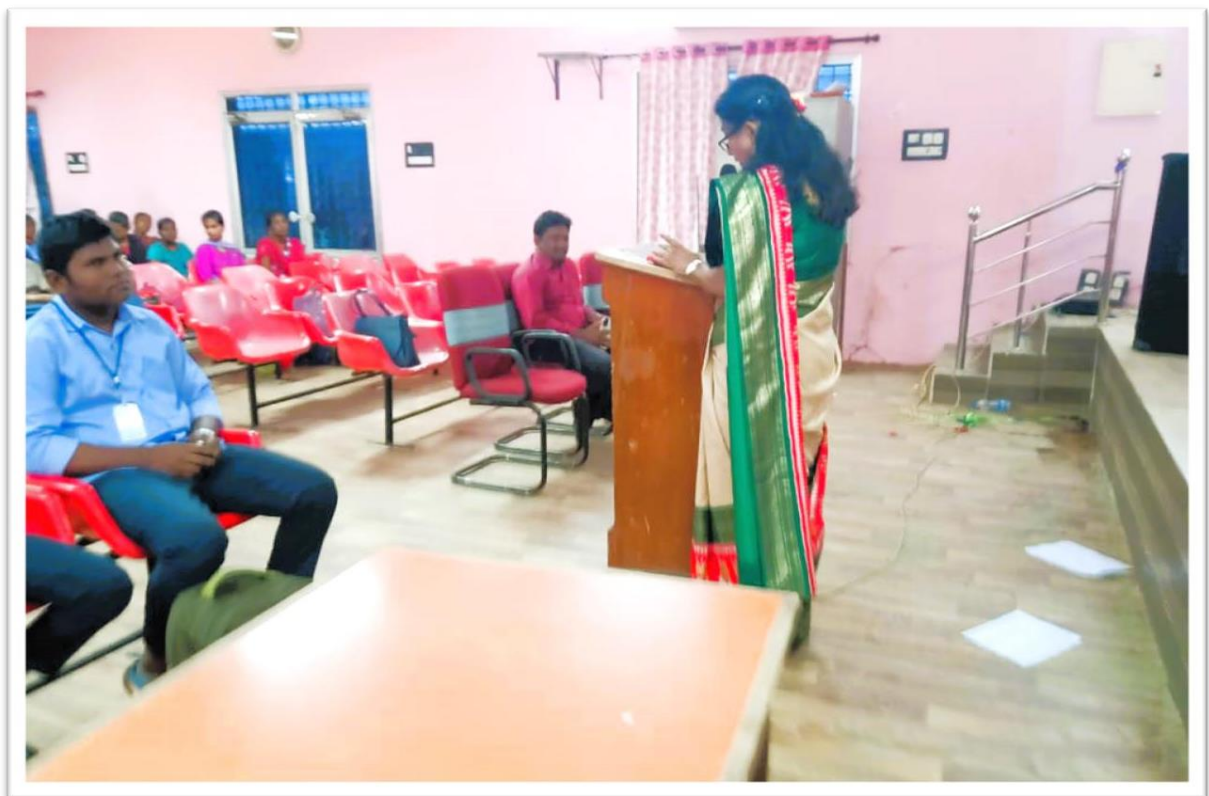
