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ABOUT NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

It was started initially in 37 universities involving 40,000 volunteers. NSS programme provide a variety of learning experiences to develop a sense of participation, service and achievement among the volunteers. The activities aim at the following:

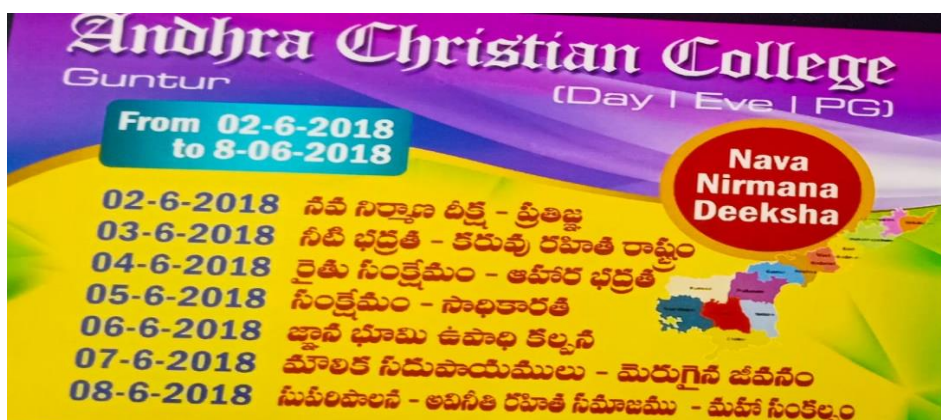

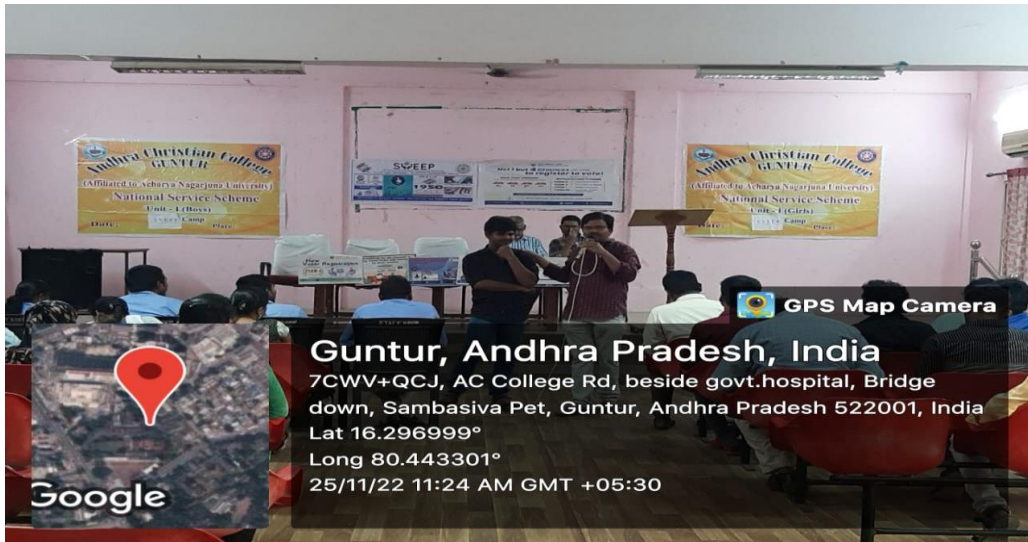
